

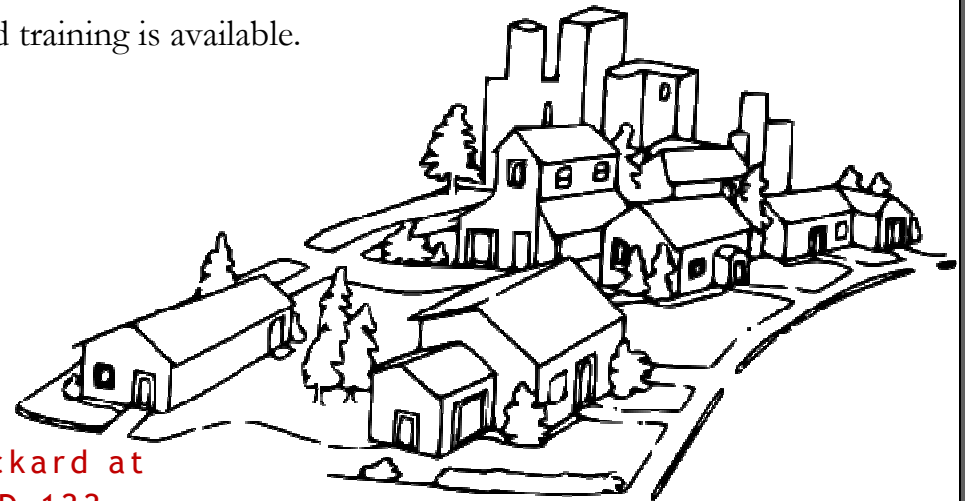
# STUDENT RESEARCHERS NEEDED

Earn up to \$10.55/hr. and strengthen your research experience and skills for graduate school or job applications.

Does the neighborhood you live in impact your health? Can your overall health outcomes (lifespan, disease, quality of life) be determined by how you feel about your neighbors? In a study titled “Good Neighbors Make Good Fences: The Effect of Social Capital on Perceptions of Neighborhood Disorder,” Dr. Packard seeks to investigate how the social conditions of a neighborhood determine how healthy people are.

Student researchers are needed to conduct interviews, analyze data and prepare papers for presentation and publication. **No previous research experience required.** Paid training is available.

Undergraduate and Graduate students are eligible.
